

## Preschool Year-At-A-Glance

### **September:** Fruits and Vegetables

Names of common fruits and vegetables, places they are grown, preparation of fruits and vegetables, seeds, and characteristics of fruits and vegetables.

Letters: A, F, S

Colors: red, yellow, blue

### **October:** Rocks

Recognize various attributes of rocks such as; color, size, shape, weight, and measurement.

Letters: P, L, O

Colors: black, orange, purple

### **November:** Clothing

To make students aware of the different types of clothing needed for different seasons.

Letters: H, T, N

Colors: brown

### **December:** Boxes

Explore social studies, science, literacy, math, and art by creating a book nook, building with boxes, wrapping, and measuring.

Letters: D, R, G, B, E

Colors: green

### **January:** Exercise

To make students aware of healthy habits and ways to take care of their bodies.

Letters: J, W, M, C

Colors: White, gray

### **February:** Shadows

Develop understanding of what a shadow is, what causes a shadow to occur, and how the characteristics of a shadow can be modified.

Letters: V, Q

Colors: pink

**March:** Bugs and Insects

Compare and contrast different types of bugs and insects.

Letters: K

Colors: Green, yellow

**April:** Trash and Garbage (Taking Care of the Earth)

To help young students learn to reduce, reuse, and recycle.

Letters: U

Colors: pastels

**May:** Flowers

Children will learn parts of the flower, names of flowers, places they grow, uses of flowers, containers that hold flowers, and care of flowers.

Letters: I, X

**June:** Zoo Animals

Children will learn kinds of zoo animals, needs of zoo animals, types of animal homes, and caretakers of zoo animals.
